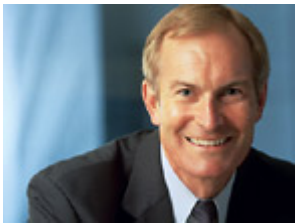

Always imperative are the recent court decisions that have made reclamation a more problematic remedy. Also to be discussed are the rights and obligations with respect to supply agreements, recoupment/setoff agreements and other executory contracts. And a discussion of the newest developments on preferences, featuring recent cases on whether credit card payments are recoverable preferences and on the new value and ordinary course of business defenses. As current trends in Chapter 11 cases include more prepackaged Chapter 11's and liquidating Chapter 11's, discussions will also be had on legal steps which can be taken before and after a customer's bankruptcy filing to enhance collectability of trade claims.
